# EXPLORE

Rhapsody Explore allows students to enhance their learning with creative sessions based around topics you cover in the curriculum.

Students will develop their knowledge of the chosen topic with explorative drama techniques allowing them to see the ideas and concepts in a new way.

As well as developing knowledge in your chosen subject area, pupils will gain valuable literacy skills in speaking and listening.

Explore workshops can be delivered on any topic you feel necessary (Science, History, Shakespeare...) Rhapsody practitioners will tailor these workshops to your needs and learning requirements.



# PERFORM

With the current demands on schools and staff it can prove difficult to continue extra - curricular activities. School productions are inclusive of all ages and abilities in school and build on teamwork, a sense of belonging and taking on responsibility.

Rhapsody Perform is a directorial service for schools. A director will liaise with your staff and facilitate a school production (musical, play, concert) to be performed at your school whenever suits your school best.

Rhapsody can provide a specific production team to aid staff and students in the running of a production. We can also use this as a training opportunity for students who wish to gain experience in production roles rather than as performers.

Perform workshops facilitate all stages of the production process from auditions to rehearsals to stage management and finally putting on the performance.



# DEVELOP

The Rhapsody Develop programme offers schools the chance to build pupils current love of performance and hone their skills through regular workshops.

Develop sessions can be run at lunchtime or after school and focus on DRAMA or MUSICAL THEATRE. Pupils will work on a variety of skills, texts, drama games and activities. These sessions promote confidence, team work and co operation.

The develop group will work on different skills and at the end of a term share what they have learnt in a showcase at your school for parents, staff, friends and family.

Lunch sessions run for 30 minutes and after school sessions 1 hour. Subject to availability.



# LEAD

The Lead programme is aimed at those students who want to further their experience in creating theatre and performance.

Rhapsody practitioners work with students who have a particular interest in direction. Sessions with pupils will help them understand what is required to create performance and how to execute their vision.

This programme works particularly well alongside the Perform sessions and allows students to be very hands on with performers and text as they work as co-director to Rhapsody staff.

Encouraging students in this way means they are more creative and feel confident to produce their own work in and out of school.


